TURNPIKE TOMMY settled in early gave a prompted middle move, pressed on the far turn shaking clear into upper stretch, angled out late from the three to the five path holding firm. BRITELUCK unhurried early circled out into upper stretch, bid seven wide angling in to the six path late salvaging place. EASTERMAN slow early stayed back through the far turn, taken eight wide in upper stretch improved position late. ROAD NOT TRAVELED hard ridden early with little response dropped well back, came five wide in upper stretch swinging out to the nine path late gaining after the fact. BAYLAND sent clear set a soft pace through the backside, hooked on the far turn ceded into upper stretch wearing down in the four path. SEBASTIAN CAT went evenly through the backside, gained ground on the far turn then leveled off while racing six wide in upper stretch. TIME LIMIT stalked the pace chasing through the far turn, extending into upper stretch gave way in the two path. JOE KNOWS ALL was always outrun.
