**Footnotes**

MURKY stalked to mid turn, bid three wide to engage DADDY'S APPLE at the quarter pole, was turned away in upper stretch, put to strong left handed stick inside the eighth pole and came again overtaking that rival late edging clear. DADDY'S APPLE sent from the gate, maintained a slim lead running in the two path, fought hard under pressure from upper stretch, ceded grudgingly in last jumps missing in a very solid performance. CARDINAL RULE settled in mid pack running off the rail, angled five wide upper stretch, chased while between foes mid stretch, slowly inched up winning the battle for third place. SKATING HOME lacked early foot running towards the rear, came six wide upper stretch, finished fastest of all nearing the wire missing a minor award. ALL THAT GLIMMERS raced up close to the pace along the rail from the start, angled out under a drive entering the stretch, lacked needed rally coming up empty. MARTINI VISION settled in the second flight, responded to urging from upper stretch showing mild late interest but failed to menace. HAVANA LIGHTS pressed for the lead to mid stretch running along the rail, shortened stride late from earlier efforts. MOVIN TO UTOPIA unhurried early, made a brief move mid turn, failed to sustain momentum and flattened out mid stretch. STARSHIP GALACTICA was always outrun, roused to no avail offering little. STARSHIP QUALITY flashed brief foot, retreated from the quarter pole finishing well beaten.
