BUEA OAK raced evenly through the turn ranging up in the four path to collar JITTER IN ROME in upper stretch, went all out abreast rival from the sixteenth pole keeping a neck up on the wire. JITTER IN ROME broke sharply clearing the field setting a solid pace through the turn, collared from the outside by BUEA OAK in upper stretch battled back missing in grudging fashion. UNDERCOVER SISTER stalked the pace edging closer to loom along the inside in upper stretch, gave all the final sixteenth to no avail. FROSTY'S FASTEST broke alertly moving evenly along the inside through the turn, hard roused to upper stretch lacked needed surge during the drive. ROCKING ZONE played no factor finishing seven wide. DANCING SCOUNDREL was never involved racing nine wide through the stretch. PRIMULA raced evenly while saving ground through the turn then weakened in upper stretch. SEEYOUNEXTUESDAY flashed early speed then gave way on the turn. POISON IVEY outrun early would tire. HOPE U RNT MOODY dropped back early.
