**Footnotes**

PERFECT SATURDAY hustled up along the rail going down the backside, moved out a bit to stalk, drew even with DREAM ROCKER leaving the quarter pole, went head to head to deep stretch, slowly edged away late under steady handling. DREAM ROCKER broke sharply and was quickly angled to the rail, maintained a slight advantage around the turn, dug in once headed by the winner, fought hard to deep stretch, yielded grudgingly proving a game second best. COMEBACK settled in mid pack, launched rally coming four wide entering the stretch, closed in on top pair nearing the wire finishing willingly. BRYNNIE'S MR. SMEE broke out brushing DREAM ROCKER, was taken in hand to rate, roused form mid turn, swung five wide upper stretch, gained some but needed more late. OURAGANS ROAR was off slowly and trailed racing wide down the backside, gained position in upper stretch, leveled off late besting rest while never menacing. TALK TIL YER BLUE raced a bit off the rail, gave chase top of the lane traveling between foes, failed to factor. SPEEDY GRAHAM lacked speed and raced in the second flight throughout, lacked response. TONY'S RETURN hustled early, saved ground on the turn giving chase, faded mid stretch. T RIFFIC CAREER raced briefly in mid pack, dropped off coming to the quarter pole. IMAGATORURAGATOR flashed speed stalking the top pair briefly, gave way leaving the quarter pole and stopped inside the eighth pole.
