Footnotes

LOVE OF LIFE pressured the pace wresting a narrow lead into the turn, shook clear there widening a bit in the two path to upper stretch holding firm late. FLASH FOREVER pressed the pace through the turn racing five wide to upper stretch, shifted to the six path under left hand urging holding on late for place. BOGEY FOR BLADE away slowly labored through the turn, swung out seven wide in upper stretch came on to finish well. Q BORDER GUARD sent hard chased six wide through the turn then weakened in upper stretch. V MAN slow early was circled out seven wide in upper stretch with little improvement. SNACK DADDY pressed four wide early chasing through the turn, wavered in upper stretch fading at mid track. SPOOKY HOLLOW pressed along the inside, chased through the turn then gave way in upper stretch. MADE THE STEAL pressed between horses pursuing three wide on the turn, would wilt in upper stretch.
