Footnotes

WHERE'S MY WIFE broke alertly and dueled outside of RUNRICORUN to the quarter pole, edged away in upper stretch, was hard ridden holding off a late surging M W'S RUMMY coming to the wire, prevailed being fully extended. M W'S RUMMY well placed stalking the winner throughout, bid three wide top of the lane, surged under a stiff drive at the finish line, just missed in a game effort. THE BIG MAN tracked a contested pace around the bend, bid four wide upper stretch, loomed off of top pair mid stretch, finished willingly needing a bit more late. LITE MUSIC settled early, rushed a five wide move at the quarter pole, held a menacing position entering the stretch, failed to sustain bid and flattened out at the furlong marker. LEGOLAS rider lost both irons coming out of the gate, had both feet in the stirrups by the five eighths pole, raced along the rail around the bend being outrun, found stride top of the stretch, showed belated action to finish with interest but failed to threaten. INCLUDE SUNSHINE lacked speed, raced mid track throughout, put to strong left handed stick and passed weary foes improving placing but never factored. RUNRICORUN rushed hard shortly after the start to put a head in front, battled with the winner to the quarter pole, was all done and gave way in upper stretch, used up. SILVER WARD hustled early racing mid pack briefly traveling three to four wide, gave way entering the stretch. SUDDSY SUNDAY stumbled badly at the start, raced wide being outrun, was eased coming to the quarter pole but did complete the course.
