LION'S DUB well handled tracking the pace along the inside, split foes mid turn mounting rally, angled to the three path upper stretch, vied in a three way battle inside the eighth pole, edged clear late and just lasted being fully extended. HIGH NATIVE FLY settled in mid pack towards the inside, sat patent to upper stretch, swung out five wide mid stretch, surged strongly nearing the wire just missing in a hard effort. KIPLING BOY broke well stalking the leader from the start, moved in tandem entering the stretch, vied mid stretch running between foes, was outfinished late holding the show position. RULER BOY well placed stalking early on, angled off the rail in upper stretch, loomed off the duelers from mid stretch, needed a bit more late. CALLING GERI showed good speed, set a solid tempo throughout running along the rail, headed mid stretch, fought hard under pressure but weakened in deep stretch. KNOWURBREW was a step slow into stride, swung out six wide under a drive upper stretch, improved position but failed to menace. PHROGPHLYER stalked down the backside, gave chase from mid turn, lacked needed punch and tired in upper stretch. R. J. SAYS settled in the second flight saving ground throughout, roused to no avail, offered little. SNOOPY ROCKS was always outrun offered little. VINCENT CAN GO raced very wide into the first turn, trailed throughout never factoring.
