FINAL JUDGEMENT rushed shortly after the start pressing TETON STAR for the lead, raced inside that rival around the bend, came out to the three path turning for home while being set down, edged away inside the eighth pole, won going away and was in hand at the finish line. JOSIAH stalked duelers down the backside, bid turning for home racing four wide, could not keep pace with the winner in the final furlong but gamely got up for second place in willing effort. TETON STAR broke alertly but was soon headed by the winner, raced outside that rival throughout, battled to mid stretch, slowly ceded and then was out nodded vying for second place. PENITANT PRAYERS raced evenly towards the inside, hard ridden top of the lane, lacked needed surge. SILVER JAZZ trailed down the backside, swung five wide entering the stretch, beat tired ones improving position but never threatened. READY TO POUNCE raced up close going down the backside, began to chase at the quarter pole, lacked response and faded in upper stretch. SONNY'S MEMORY was a step slow into stride, offered little. STARLITS LAD was always outrun, never factored.
