Footnotes

STERLING EMBLEM raced up close to a contested pace, bid three wide nearing the quarter pole engaging POLKA TIME for the lead, drew clear in upper stretch and widened being kept to task. POLKA TIME bumped with MADLY at the break, quickly rushed to to vie for the lead, headed by the winner at the quarter pole, battled to top of the lane, proved no match in the drive then dug in late preserving the place position. IMA GIVEN unhurried racing wide down the backside, was carried out mid turn, came four to five wide entering the stretch, got the show position under a stiff drive. SENTIMENTAL raced evenly at mid track down the backstretch, hard ridden from the quarter pole, failed to menace traveling between foes from mid stretch. MADLY bumped with POLKA TIME at the break, settled along the rail chasing the pace, lacked needed response when asked, no threat. NANCY'S P. T. lacked speed racing towards the rear, was carried out mid turn when REGAL DIAMOND took a bad step and was being moved wide, failed to factor in the drive despite being hard ridden. REGAL DIAMOND matched strides with the runner up down the backside, took a bad step at the three eighths pole, was being moved out wide and herded a couple of rivals briefly, dropped far off and was eased in the stretch.
