Footnotes

OLD FASHION MAN quickly showed in front, set all the pace racing in the two path, held safe advantage late under steady handling. I'D MARRY ME stalked the winner around the turn, was under strong left handed stick from upper stretch, needed more holding on to second place. DREAM OF SIDNEY tracked racing mid track, came four wide under a drive entering the stretch, lacked surge and fought hard late saving third place. TOO MANY WHYZ raced evenly in mid pack, gained along the rail in deep stretch to narrowly miss the show position. FIRST INVESTMENT raced in the second flight, improved some deep stretch running four to five wide, no real threat. MIDTOWN BAILEY lacked speed running towards the rear, did show some belated interest coming to the wire but failed to menace. MAGIC RIDE dueled briefly with the winner, chased from the quarter pole, faded mid stretch. ROLLIN CATAMINE raced briefly in mid pack, retreated form the quarter pole, no factor. BUZZIN READY was off slowly trailing along the rail, showed little. PRINCELY SPIRIT settled in the second flight, traveled four to five wide around the bend, gave way mid stretch.
