NORTHERN PRINCE patiently ridden traveling well off the rail lagging far off the early pace, urged going into the far turn, chased loose leader from the quarter pole, blew by a weary SEATTLE EXPRESSO mid stretch to win going away. SEATTLE EXPRESSO rushed to the front, continued on opening a large lead down the backside, began to tire top of the stretch, had nothing left inside the eighth pole but managed to hold on to second place under encouragement. DESTINED TO SHINE tracked a loose leader throughout, hard ridden past the quarter pole, lacked late kick besting rest. KENNY THE SALESMAN raced towards the inside throughout, failed to respond when roused, never menaced. MARK JUMPS varied little traveling four wide down the backstretch, never threatened. MITCH'S TWO BELOW was outrun early, offered little. STRICKS CHAIRMAN flashed brief foot, stopped mid turn finishing well beaten.
