HONOUR ABOVE SELF broke alertly quickly showing in front, set a sharp pace throughout, raced in the thee path entering the stretch being threatened by SHARPEST CAT began to drift out sharply nearing the finish line carrying out that rival despite receiving strong right handed whip, prevailed being fully extended. SHARPEST CAT stalked the winner throughout, bid for the lead turning for home, almost drew even mid stretch, was carried out by the winner coming to the wire, just missed in a game effort. LEMON SPRAY stalked down the backside, gave chase along the rail entering the stretch, failed to threaten top pair but dug in saving the show position in willing manner. CHOCOLATE KNIGHT tracked racing off the rail down the backside, rallied three to four wide top of the lane, never menaced top pair and lost the duel vying for third place. PLEASANT COMPANY settled in the second flight, angled mid turn, came six wide upper stretch, gave belated surge in deep stretch. ACCESS TO THE CITY was well placed early on, put to a drive mid turn, lacked response never threatening. SECOND THOUGHTS unhurried early traveling in the second flight, failed to factor. POSTTENSION lagged to mid turn, did pass tiring foes but never factored. KING OF LORDS was outrun racing mid track. SMOKY KNIGHT gave chase top the half, dropped off leaving the quarter pole, stopped mid stretch finishing well beaten.
