TREVOR'S FAST CAT pressed CATMOOCHIE down the backstretch, took back slightly going into the far turn to move off the rail, stalked to the quarter pole, bid three wide entering the stretch and quickly blew by taking the lead in upper stretch, won comfortably being ridden out. TOO SHY TO TELL raced sluggishly in the early going, finally found stride top of the lane, closed rapidly inside the eighth pole picking up second place. FUPEG'S DELIGHT settled early racing mid track, mounted bid coming four wide top of the stretch, chased winner in the drive, was outfinished late vying for second place. CATMOOCHIE broke sharply gaining control, set the pace to the quarter pole, had little resistance when headed by TREVOR'S FAST CAT entering the stretch, gave way at the eighth pole, used up. MY CASH BOX stumbled at the break, hustled up racing in mid pack, failed to respond when asked, never threatened. JASMINE STORM was off late being quickly outrun, raced greenly down the backstretch, never involved. LUDACIA showed good speed stalking down the backside, gave chase from the quarter pole, stopped mid stretch and was eased across the finish line.
