SECRET CARESS slow early advanced to contention on the turn, put a head in front outside the eighth pole drawing away under a drive near mid track. TOORALOORACOLLORA bumped at the break was caught five wide through the turn coming six wide down the stretch rallying late for place. SPANISH SALSA broke alertly pressuring the pace dueling with KNOTTS through the turn, extending into upper stretch would wear down late in the three path. KNOTTS broke sharply pressuring on pace through the turn dueling into upper stretch, asked for more there would come up short in the two path. DANCING WONDER pinched back at the break played no factor. SUNSHINE RADIANCE veered out crowding rivals at the break, hustled off the pace would tire in upper stretch. MOGEY remained sluggish throughout. NAUSET LIGHT raced evenly through the turn then folded in upper stretch.
