**Footnotes**

MORGANS CREEK broke alertly, was taken to the rail to save ground, stalked STRONG CAT soon after the start, had room to challenge for the lead leaving the quarter pole, vied inside of STRONG CAT top of the lane, edged away mid stretch, held safe under steady encouragement. PATTON PENDING well placed throughout, hard ridden swinging five wide upper stretch, received severe left handed stick, closed gap in willing manner. MARSHALL ROOSTER (GB) settled in the second flight, rallied leaving the quarter pole, traveled between foes upper stretch, angled towards the inside with a sixteenth to go, caused the rider of INTEMPERATE to steady briefly, surged gamely to secure the show position. GO CALEB GO trailed to the far turn, gained momentum leaving the quarter pole, rallied between foes during the stretch run, was going well nearing the finish. STRONG CAT rushed off and set a pressured pace throughout, traveled a little bit off the inside, headed by the winner leaving the quarter pole, dug in to battle to mid stretch, gave way in deep stretch. OUT COACHED hustled and raced wide going into the first turn, stalked while three to four wide down the backside, loomed at the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid, flattened out mid stretch. HONORING BLUE held a good tracking position, raced five wide and between rivals at the half, continued wide on the turn, was seven wide upper stretch, lacked needed late kick. INTEMPERATE was off a step slow, settled towards the rear, rallied entering the stretch, was in tight racing between foes at the sixteenth pole, had to steady briefly, angled late for room, no threat. DARE TO COMPARE raced evenly along the rail throughout, hard ridden top of the stretch, failed to menace. RAYWICK raced six wide down the backstretch, lost ground on the turn, weakened in the drive. A stewards inquiry into the stretch run resulted in no change to the order of finish.
