JAZZ COURT slow early fired from the quarter pole circling out six wide in upper stretch wresting the lead while angling further out to the eight path winning going away. CAMPTON away slowly stayed back through the turn, fired in the three path upper stretch bidding gamely the final eighth. BARBARA'S CHOICE outrun through the turn swung out seven wide in upper stretch threatening near the eighth pole, lost some momentum late giving an even finish. CARTER ROAD chased the pace pressing up to challenge on the turn, extending at mid track in upper stretch would weaken late. LAGOON slow early came five wide in upper stretch finishing evenly at mid track. SOLUTIONFINDERS slow early circled out eight wide in upper stretch. MEEK MAN chased early then faded on the turn. RED DWARF broke sharply setting the pace through the turn, gave way along the inside in upper stretch.
