ON MY WAY HOME quickly showed in front, set a solid pace running along the inside, kept all rivals at bay winning comfortably being ridden out. BONITA MUNECA stalked the winner saving ground throughout, angled out upper stretch, failed to menace while holding second place in a hard effort. LADY SAXONY rated and traveled in the second flight, came four wide upper stretch, closed willingly picking up third place. ONLY ONE FOR ME unhurried leaving the gate and trailed in the early stages, roused coming five wide upper stretch, improved position but never threatened. VENGANZA was forwardly placed traveling two to three wide, loomed mid turn under a drive, flattened out mid stretch. LITTLE SADIE raced evenly in mid pack, roused to no avail, never menaced. TARTAN SKY raced up close to the far turn, began to fade leaving the quarter pole, used up. CASKET MODEL was off a step slow, raced mid track throughout, weakened mid turn offering little.
