DAILY STAR settled early advanced on the turn, vied from mid track upper stretch wresting the lead drawing out under a hand ride. RUSSIAN KITTEN chased the pace through the turn moving closer from the four path upper stretch, extending under right hand urging would drift in a bit saving place in the three slot. TRADITIONALISM broke alertly pressuring to lead on the turn, hooked along the inside in upper stretch would weaken late. JUICY LOOTS raced evenly through the turn angling five wide in upper stretch, hard roused there lacked needed surge. ELIZABETH'S DREAM pressured early between horses, chased through the turn to upper stretch, would fade in close quarters late. BRIGHTIA RUBY slow early swung out six wide in upper stretch. CONSUMED BY JEWEL pressed then chased along the rail through the turn, began to waver in upper stretch dropping back when empty late. TEN CARROT NIKKI flashed early speed then gave way on the turn, was put away mid stretch easing to the wire.
