ENGLISH TEACHER well placed soon after the start, sat patient to the far turn, moved up three wide mid turn, dueled at the quarter pole racing abreast rivals, cleared entering the stretch and angled towards the rail, drew off mid stretch being kept to task. I'LL FIND YOU unhurried leaving the gate, settled towards the rear, gained coming to the quarter pole, was abruptly angled out seven wide upper stretch, finished fast securing second place but never threatened the winner. LEXIACOMO trailed entering the backside, saved ground to top of the lane, swung out eight wide upper stretch, surged belatedly picking up a minor award. MAUMENEE set a rated pace running along the inside, headed from the far turn, battled gamely to upper stretch, weakened at the furlong marker, bested rest proving no late factor. CIRCLINGWEND raced up close from the start, vied in a three way duel running between foes at the quarter pole, was all done at the sixteenth pole. LA PESCADITA tracked the pace racing along the rail down the backside, urged mid turn, lacked response and faded from upper stretch. SHES A STEPPER lacked speed traveling four wide to the half, asked for more on the bend, failed to respond, never threatened. CHATTY CAT showed brief foot, chased running along the rail to midway on the second turn, gave way finishing spent. PINCH OF JOY lacked speed racing a little off the rail, failed to factor in a dull effort. FRIENDLY MISTRESS made a slight hop at the break, hustled up to race in mid pack to the far turn, gave way coming to the quarter pole, was eased in upper stretch, .
