Footnotes

BRIDAL TRAIN away well laid close up engaging THIS IS ELIZA on the turn, dueled abreast rival in the three path down the lane extending to clear late. THIS IS ELIZA broke sharply setting the early pace, hooked from the outside on the turn battled BRIDAL TRAIN through the stretch ceding grudgingly late in the two path. TRIBAL VERSE a step slow early raced three path to upper stretch going all out to best the others. FASIG GIRL in tight at the break was hustled through the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch gave an even finish. TRY ME bobbling at the break raced evenly off the loose leaders lacking late surge in the four path. PREEMINENT in close at the break would remain a step slow throughout.
