Footnotes

CHINCHILLA unhurried from the break, went evenly through the turn, rallied 4 wide inside the 1/4 pole, angled 5 wide in mid drive, surged abreast rivals to power past LOW PROFILE in the closing yards. LOW PROFILE hustled out for the early lead, pressed hard by BROKEN SMILE working to maintain edge through the turn, extended for more when encountered by CHINCHILLA who had emerged on the outside, couldn't hold off rival late. RELAUNCH QUEEN laid close to the early pace, followed a hard used LOW PROFILE through the turn, loomed between horses in mid drive, came up a little short nearing the wire. BROKEN SMILE fired out with good early speed, pressed LOW PROFILE racing at the rail pushing the leader through the turn, battled into upper stretch wearing down the final 1/16. BANK THE DOE raced evenly off the pace, made a mild move to bid in upper stretch, would have no late surge weakening under the whip. NAUGHTY FEVER was bumped in close quarters at the break, dropped well back early, played no factor. TIZ SPANISH sent hard pursuing the pace, wavered outside the 1/4 pole, gave way into lane. IMA PRIZED in close quarters at the break, was never involved. STOLEN CRYSTAL outrun early, wilted on the turn.
