SOME PEOPLE CHANGE sent clear early moved a solid pace racing along the inside through the turn, left no doubt moving off in upper stretch while kept to the whip winning much the best. EASTOVERS REVENGE raced evenly off the pace saving ground cutting the corner to emerge off a loose SOME PEOPLE CHANGE in upper stretch, no match for the winner gave good response securing place. FIVE FOOT NOTHING slow early was circled out into upper stretch, found stride on the far outside gaining with even late action while eight wide. DECO DOC was acting up tangling in the gate breaking late, trailing through the turn would pick up tired ones from mid track through the lane. ST. ELMORE raced evenly in mid pack gaining some ground along the inside in upper stretch, weakened the final sixteenth. TOO WILD hustled along raced five and six wide through the turn to upper stretch, would wear down in drive. STIG'S DEPUTY sent hard pursued SOME PEOPLE CHANGE under urging through the turn, became leg weary in upper stretch giving way. ROCKINFULLTHROTTLE was always outrun. A P KNIGHT raced second flight flattening out in upper stretch. WAR SPACE broke alert chasing through the turn, wilted in upper stretch.
