Footnotes

NICOLE'S DREAM broke to a quick lead, went measured on the inside of TWIN METEORS near the 1/4 pole, cut loose to open up mid stretch, in command late finishing under wraps. TWIN METEORS broke alertly pursuing NICOLE'S DREAM into the turn, tried rival edging closer at the 1/4 pole, was rebuffed in upper stretch, though clearly no match for winner remained game salvaging place. BURST FIRST a step slow from the break, struggled through the turn, responded 3 wide in mid drive, bid willingly to wire. FRANKIE R'S WINNER hustled to go close up, angled inside entering the turn, pursued with a chance in drive, needed a surge late. TWILITE TESTIMONEY sluggish in the early going, was rushed 4 wide with little change on the turn, had some response to move closer in drive. PRINCE GEORGI broke well chasing at the rail, remained close through the turn, extended in upper stretch, weakened under a drive. REVERED SOLDIER outrun run under early prompting, angled to rail on turn, had no rally in drive. PATTON PENDING dropped well back early, was never involved.
