Footnotes

SERUNI moved to the two path stalking DREAMED DAY going down the backside, bid for the lead leaving the far turn, went clear then was threatened by CRYPTOLIGHT at the quarter pole, repulsed that challenge in mid stretch, won comfortably under steady handling. CRYPTOLIGHT was forwardly placed from the start, sat patient traveling three wide to the far turn, gained from mid turn almost drawing even with the winner at the quarter pole, was turned away by mid stretch and settled for second best. SNEAKIN THRU settled in good tracking position running along the inside to midway on the second turn, put to a drive angling five wide entering the stretch, failed to threaten top pair while besting rest. SUNSHINE KID lagged for the opening half mile, urged from mid turn, swung six wide top of the lane, showed belated action improving placing but was no real threat. CAUSIN' HAVOC raced evenly in mid pack saving ground, angled coming to the quarter pole under a drive, failed to respond, never menaced. DREAMED DAY quickly showed in front, set a pressured pace down the backside, lost control to the winner at the three eighths pole, was all done giving way top of the stretch finishing spent. NUWELL was always outrun, never involved.
