Footnotes

GONE PROSPECTING slow early saved ground to mid turn, angled out in upper stretch firing five wide angling back in late grabbing GONE GRAND in the closing strides. GONE GRAND pressed early three deep shaking clear on the turn, digging in from the two path down the stretch would be caught at the wire. SAUCY'S IMAGE moved evenly in mid pack through the turn, emerged off a loose GONE GRAND in the three path upper stretch, extending late needed more. FAST FASHION slow early was angled four wide in upper stretch improving a bit with even action. LITTLE SKEET pressed between early then chased on the turn, wilted in upper stretch retreating in the two path. WISH UPON THE MOON was always outrun. FLIP FLOP pressured early inside ceding to GONE GRAND on the turn, would give way empty along the rail in upper stretch.
