**Footnotes**

SPIRITWOOD raced up close throughout while in hand, bid along the rail going into the far turn, was briefly turned away by PLEASANT COMPANY, took back angled along coming to the quarter pole, came again and drove clear top of the stretch, held safe being kept to the task to the finish line. HIGH SIGN settled along the rail being restrained for the opening mile, angled leaving the far turn, bid four wide chasing the winner top of the stretch, won the battle getting the place position in last strides. PLEASANT COMPANY set a well rated pace running a little off the rail, headed by the winner going into the far turn, repulsed that threat, could not fend off SPIRITWOOD a second time in upper stretch, ceded stubbornly and then just missed second place in a very hard effort. GREEN BOY unhurried for a mile and a half, swung five wide entering the stretch, finished with interest besting rest. TRES COPAS tracked the pace traveling four wide at the mile marker, began to chase with three furlongs to go, lacked response and failed to menace. POSTTENSION trailed running along the rail, hard ridden mid turn, failed to threaten. ELEUTERIO rushed a middle move to press PLEASANT COMPANY, started to weaken after a mile and a half, no factor in the stretch. J D'S FIRECRACKER raced up close for the opening mile, was all done and faded after a mile and a half, no factor.
