TURF ELITE taken in hand traveling towards the rear along the rail down the backstretch, advanced mid turn saving ground, hugged the rail entering the stretch, vied in a three way battle inside the eighth pole, drifted out in deep stretch crowding REBELLION DOG and continued outward to herd MAJESTY LANE, prevailed late under strong handling. MAJESTY LANE tracked down the backside racing towards the inside, angled out top of the lane, surged inside the eighth pole, drew even mid stretch, had to steady late when TURF ELITE drifted out, managed to save second place in a willing effort. A STEWARDS INQUIRY WAS FOLLOWED BY A CLAIM OF FOUL FROM THE RIDER OF MAJESTY LANE AGAINST THE RIDER OF TURF ELITE FOR INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH, AFTER REVIEW THIS CLAIM WAS UPHELD AND TURF ELITE WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACE SECOND. REBELLION DOG set a pressured pace throughout, battled gamely to deep stretch, headed from both sides mid stretch, had to briefly check when TURF ELITE drifted out in deep stretch. REMEMBER ME ADENA unhurried leaving the gate, gained mid turn while splitting rivals, closed strongly in deep stretch besting rest but never menaced. HEAVENLY EXECUTIVE well placed tracking the pace racing off the rail, hard ridden giving chase form the quarter pole, failed to respond needing more. DUKE OF DITTMAN raced evenly saving ground down the backside, angled out to the four path under a drive in upper stretch, lacked needed surge. STACK O' DOLLARS settled in the second flight traveling at mid track, failed to threaten despite being hard ridden. SIR WILLIAM pressed the leader for six furlongs, had enough and gave way in upper stretch, used up. JAY JAY DYNAMITE was quickly outrun, dropped far off the pace going into the far turn, eased coming to the quarter pole but did complete the course.
