Footnotes

ROSE BRUSH vied for the early lead racing between foes, lost position mid turn and dropped over to the rail, came again under a stiff drive in upper stretch, wore down PRIMARY KATE in deep stretch and won drawing off under strong handling. PRIMARY KATE rushed hard soon after the start, moved clear mid turn traveling in the four path, fought hard when headed by ROSE BRUSH inside the eighth pole, yielded control late and was all out to save second place. DANCER SPIRIT broke alertly and vied briefly for the lead, dropped off mid turn, cut the corner entering the stretch, showed good late action in deep stretch missing second place. AWAASSIF settled towards the rear, angled to mid track in upper stretch, split rivals mid stretch racing three wide, finished with interest missing a minor award. TOO TOUGH SISSY settled in the second flight racing wide, put to left handed stick entering the stretch, gave chase but needed more late. KUTLOOSE raced in good tracking position soon after the start, dropped off on the bend, swung out five to six wide in upper stretch, lacked needed kick. CONSOLVER rushed and vied for the lead racing three wide and between foes mid turn, began to weaken mid stretch, no late threat. SPEEDY BULLET was lightly brushed leaving the gate, trailed soon after, lagged throughout offering little.
