TEXAS FLEETING broke alertly and dueled for the lead from the start, battled with FLUTTERING to the quarter pole, put that rival away in upper stretch but was then headed by JAZILLION SMILES mid stretch, turned that rival away inside the eighth pole and widened late under steady handling. MELLIFERA settled in mid pack, asked top of the lane, angled towards the inside mid stretch, hit best stride late and surged strongly securing second place in a willing manner. JAZILLION SMILES was never far off the pace, bid three wide mid stretch and loomed off the winner, leveled off and was outfinished late fighting for second place. FLEET LAUREN tracked around the turn racing at mid track, hard ridden from top of the stretch, lacked needed punch besting rest. KISSES FROM OCALA was bumped by I'M A LUCKY NICKLE leaving the gate, settled in the second flight, raced four to five wide under a drive entering the stretch, mildly improved position but failed to menace. ABOVE GRADE trailed to mid turn, angled towards the inside mid stretch, never factored. FLUTTERING was hard used in the early going vying for the lead, began to give way top of the stretch, spent. I'M A LUCKY NICKLE broke inward bumping KISSES FROM OCALA, trailed throughout offering little.
