LA MALAGUENA settled towards the rear, rallied mid turn, came three wide into the stretch, dueled with FIGHTING XENA to deep stretch, slowly edged away late under strong encouragement. FIGHTING XENA stalked a loose leader to mid turn, quickly gained and took over in upper stretch, dug in when headed by LA MALAGUENA in deep stretch, yielded stubbornly saving second place under full extension. PROENZA unhurried from the gate trailing to the far turn, advanced from mid turn, swung four wide for the stretch run, closed willingly under a stiff drive narrowly missing second place in a hard effort. MY PRINCESS DAWN tracked to the far turn, moved on the bend running between foes, chased in the drive but never menaced besting rest. LUBAVA settled in the second flight running in the four path, passed tiring foes improving placing but never factored. STRAVLOVA lacked speed, never involved. TIZ ROSES quickly showed in front and opened up a large lead setting a blistering pace, began to shorten stride turning for home, faltered mid stretch finishing spent. BOURBON BEST gave chase along the rail to mid turn, faded entering the stretch, used up.
