Footnotes

RICHOCHET laid close showing early speed, dueled from mid track in upper stretch edging off under a drive. YOYO JABO circled out while advancing on the turn, looming abreast rivals in upper stretch wavered a bit finding enough to salvage place. DR. FURLOW hustled in early pursuit was swung out seven wide in upper stretch, gave even late action needing more. CAST NO SHADOW rushed up inside pressured the pace dueling into upper stretch, extended to outside pressure would weaken late. HIGH VALUE TARGET broke sharply engaging on pace dueling between horses through the turn, wavered in upper stretch fading off near the eighth pole. GENERAL JOSH sent inside showed early speed then dropped back on the turn. CAYENNE GREY failed to respond. BLAAZAN DYER pressed the early pace, weakened on the turn then gave way in upper stretch. ABSOLUTELY JOE labored well back.
