**Footnotes**

LONG RANGE MISSILE broke alertly and set a pressured pace, traveled in the four path from top of the stretch, was under an all out drive to the wire holding rivals, prevailed being fully extended. EXCHANGE NOTE stalked around the bend, bid outside of LONG RANGE MISSILE in upper stretch, vied running between foes from the eighth pole, was held safe by the winner but gamely secured second place under a stiff drive. ROAD RAGE tracked to mid turn, bid near the quarter pole almost drawing even racing widest in a three way battle, needed a bit more late being outgamed by top pair at the finish line. WILD GOOSE CREEK rushed a four to five wide move mid turn, loomed off duelers at the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid and leveled off mid stretch besting rest. WILD INQUIRY raced mid pack and off the rail, roused entering the stretch racing four wide, lacked punch. SIXTH FORMAL lacked speed racing mid track throughout, mildly improved placing but never threatened. INTENSLYCONFUZZLED was forwardly placed in the early going, raced up close to the quarter pole, began to fade in upper stretch, no late factor. KING T C was quickly outrun, swung eight wide top of the stretch, showed little. ONE FINE ENDEAVOUR was always outrun racing mid track. TIME TELLS ALL was urged in the early stages giving chase, dropped off leaving the quarter pole, used up.
