FINAL ANSWER was a step slow from the gate, settled towards the rear, made a quick four to five wide move midway on the turn, took aim on RUM RIGHT turning for home, dueled with that rival to the sixteenth pole then slowly edged away under strong handling. RUM RIGHT broke sharply to take an immediate lead, traveled towards the inside around the bend, matched strides when headed by the winner to deep stretch, yielded grudgingly proving second best. PROPER RESPECT well placed early and saved ground throughout, lacked needed surge despite being hard ridden just holding on to third place. BACKSTAGE DRAMA lacked speed and raced mid track, swung five wide upper stretch, showed mild late interest improving placing but failed to menace. UPTONOW flashed speed stalking early, raced between foes on the bend, failed to threaten while under a drive. OCEANAGE rushed a four wide bid near the quarter pole, chased entering the stretch, flattened out at the furlong marker. ARCH DIRECTOR raced up close running between foes, was in close going into the far turn losing position, failed to factor thereafter. SAL'S GOLD was urged shortly after the start but failed to respond, dropped off to trail around the turn, showed little.
