Footnotes

BONITA BETS broke alertly gaining a slight early advantage, shook free at the quarter pole, was kept to left handed stick in the drive holding safe. GLOW GIRL GO tracked around the turn, roused coming three wide top of the lane, closed willingly picking up second place late. SEA WHY pressed the winner to mid turn, could not keep pace from upper stretch, was edged out of second place late in a hard effort. WHY IZZY WHY raced mid pack traveling between rivals on the turn, angled towards the rail under a drive in upper stretch, lacked rally never threatening. FLOWER GIRL trailed early racing mid track, hard ridden into the stretch, slightly improved position but failed to menace. STRIPE E lacked early speed, was in tight going into the far turn steady and brushed the rail briefly, trailed mid turn, angled five wide mid stretch under a drive, failed to factor. NATALIE'S CASTLE raced up close along the rail to the quarter pole, began to fade in upper stretch.
