AWESOME AFFAIR broke sharply hustling on a clear lead through the turn, digging in from the three path upper stretch would drop to the rail late hanging on. FAVORITE FLASHBACK slow early angled five wide to upper stretch firing late gaining at mid track. FORMAL TESTIMONY away slowly trailed the field through the turn, circled six wide in upper stretch responded belatedly finding best in the last yards. BE BOPPIN WYNN a step slow early was hustled along coming three wide to upper stretch, angled to mid track late finished evenly. HE'S A DIXIE BOY raced evenly off the pace through the turn, rallied along the inside threatening in upper stretch then leveled off late in the two path. NEIL THE KNIFE raced second flight failing to menace. FOURTH TOP gave hard pursuit through the turn then faded at mid track in upper stretch. LATENIGHTOFFICER raced mid pack through the turn then folded while five wide in upper stretch.
