GOVENORS EGO came away alertly, pressed clear through the turn, drifted 8 wide entering lane, recovered on the far outside, drew off to win handily. TARZETTE broke sharply, pressed into turn, bid all out through the lane, no match for wide rival, saved place. ANNIE WARBUCKS unhurried, dropped well back, angled out inside the 1/4 pole, responded in drive to finish well. DIAMOND LEGS hustled inside, moved to bid turn, loomed upper stretch, kept to hard drive, wore down inside the 1/8 pole. NEATLY outrun early, modest gain to 1/4 pole, no serious factor. MICROSCOPE hustled off the pace, began to labor on turn, faded. POWERFUL DIVA outrun early, dropped back, folded.
