IN SESSION stalked evenly through the turn, bid five wide upper stretch, surged up in the closing strides. OCHO CABALLOS slow early circled six wide to upper stretch, hit stride on the outside, closed in abreast rivals late. PULASKI COUNTY sent clear set an inside pace through the turn, dug in near rail ceding the lead in upper stretch, gave all to wire. LODS tracked the pace through the turn, bid at mid track upper stretch, went all out to wire. NEON NIGHTS chased and pressed through the turn, led three path upper stretch, came up a bit short. RAMBLIN MIKE slow early angled inside upper stretch, finished along the rail. TWO SEAT PETE dropped off on the turn. AMERICAN MINER offered little. THE ONE TO CHASE folded up on the turn.
