BONNRITA sent clear from the break set honest splits through the far turn, collared by STIVALETTO in upper stretch fought back determinedly to prevail. STIVALETTO well placed sat off BONNRITA through the far turn surging to draw even abreast the pacesetter in upper stretch, going fully extended couldn't get by the game rival settling for place. LIVELY EXIT raced evenly giving a mild move into upper stretch, found best stride late closing in after the fact. ROCK AND DEAL unhurried in second flight gave an even move down the lane to best others. WAY OF AN EAGLE tracked the pace at mid pack wearing down after half a mile. IM FOR LEXI played no factor. HILL ROAD LOVER was always outrun. FREE WHISKEY offered little.
