HARPERS LAND rated back early fired on the far turn surging to upper stretch, wrested the lead in the three path drawing out under urging. KELLHAM prompted the pace carrying a narrow lead down the backside through the far turn, engaged by HARPERS LAND in upper stretch quickly proved no match hanging on late to salvage place. ROAR TIGER ROAR stalked early pressing up to challenge on the backside, dueled with KELLHAM through the far turn wavering a bit in upper stretch, continuing on along the inside was crowded by RED JUGGERNAUT at the wire. RED JUGGERNAUT tracked the pace threatening into the far turn, began to waver inside the quarter pole making no headway down the stretch lugging in at the wire. CHARLES THE HAMMER racing wide early proved no menace finishing near mid track. BLUE SOLDIER saved ground giving a modest move in upper stretch before leveling off late. DEVIL BY SANDY rushed to the front contested early then wilted on the far turn, was put away in upper stretch easing to the wire.
