LIFT OFF away slowly rushed up six wide on the turn, bid in the six path down the stretch getting up gamely. WYNN BY GEORGE stalked close up through the turn, pressed into upper stretch, dueling late was outfinished. SIX MILLER'S slow early angled five wide upper stretch, finished evenly. MIRROR BALL tracked through the turn, saved ground to upper stretch going evenly late along the rail. MUNRONIAN lost ground through the turn, raced six wide upper stretch, proved no menace. SEASIDE NATIVE sent clear set the pace on the inside, ceded into upper stretch, had little left late. NITE TRAIN was never involved racing wide. MR. SOURLAND raced second flight, faded into upper stretch. ROLLIN CATAMINE chased through the turn then gave way in upper stretch. GENERAL STALLINGS struggled at the back.
