Footnotes

ON TOUR stalked early, pressed three deep on the turn, wrested a short lead in upper stretch then edged away driving. SHORE TEE tracked evenly on the turn, rallied at mid track in upper stretch clearing late for place. MERCILESS RAY raced mid pack through the turn, lost ground to upper stretch giving limited response to best the others. PLANTED PINES was hustled out pressing between horses on the turn then weakened from the eighth pole. BOLDER COURSE broke sharply pressed on pace through the turn, ceded along the inside to upper stretch then wore out. SALZBURG SLEW slow early played no factor. BANKER'S RESERVE was in tight at the break, struggled throughout. LARK'S TUNE chased early then gave way on the turn. LIVE YOUR DASH was always outrun. SALT WATER SLAM was bumped at the break, dropped well back and was eased to wire.
