Footnotes

TIZ A THEME tracked the pace to the quarter pole, bid three wide top of the lane, drew even with MURDOCK in mid stretch, edged away in deep stretch under strong urging. MURDOCK pressed for the lead from the start, edged clear at the quarter pole, had the rail top of the lane, dug in when headed by TIZ A THEME in mid stretch, yielded grudgingly at the sixteenth pole proving a willing second best. MAY KING lacked speed running towards the rear, swung to the six path in upper stretch, found stride inside the eighth pole, gave best action too late grabbing the show position. MAXOPICO settled in the second flight, came five wide under left handed stick in upper stretch, needed more late being outfinished for a minor award. CHUALO trailed to the quarter pole, came six to seven wide in upper stretch, gave belated action improving placing but never menaced. LOGGED settled early, gained at the quarter pole racing four wide, loomed off the duelers entering the stretch, gave chase in the lane but flattened out inside the furlong marker. KEY TO WINNING raced up close to mid turn, angled towards the rail leaving the quarter pole, weakened from upper stretch. RIO STAR was hard used in the early going, battled to top of the stretch, had nothing left by mid stretch and gave way. COPY THOSE NOTES lacked speed, offered little. RADICCHIO made a slight bobble at the break, rushed up running between foes around the bend racing in mid pack, gave way turning for home.
