**Footnotes**

CATHYS BREEZE pressed the pace from the two path, moved to the front at the half, raced with a clear lead along the rail past the quarter pole, was hard ridden inside the eighth pole holding safe to the finish. MOONWARD unhurried in the early stages, saved ground throughout, quickly advanced entering the stretch, angled off the rail in deep stretch closing in on the winner, settled for second place in a hard effort. SUAVE FOX raced four wide stalking the pace down the backside, bid three wide at the quarter pole and loomed off the winner entering the stretch, gave chase to the wire but needed a bit more late and was edged out of second place. HIT KING settled in the second flight traveling mid track, roused mid turn, split foes mid stretch, improved placing besting rest. STORM BY settled in mid pack, rallied four wide at the quarter pole, leveled off mid stretch despite being hard ridden. GENERAL STALLINGS tracked racing along the rail to the far turn, angled out turning for home, raced four to five wide giving chase in the drive, lacked late kick. NOT ANY PRICE raced up close running three wide to the half, remained a threat to the quarter pole, began to fade in upper stretch. GOVERNOR KHALIFA varied little racing towards the rear, never factored. KELA'S HEAT sent early and held the lead briefly, was all done midway on the second turn, stopped top of the stretch finishing weary. FRED'S ALY was off late and walked out of the gate, lagged far off the pace, dull effort.
