Footnotes

NOBLE CAVALIER broke sharply wresting then working a short lead through the turn, digging in down the stretch held on to outside pressure in the four path. MARYLOVESTETON tracked the pace angling out on the turn, bid from mid track going between horses late just missing. FINAL FITZ bumped at the break stayed back through the turn, came six wide in upper stretch vying willingly late. COFFEE GOSSIP slow early varied little through the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch finished evenly. ALLEY DANCER racing a step slow through the turn angled to the three path in upper stretch proving no menace. RIDIN' HARD saved ground playing no factor along the rail. SOLD MY SOUL sent hard pressed then chased on the turn giving way in upper stretch. NO FEAR HEAR hustled out pressured the pace through the turn then wilted in upper stretch. CHARLES THE HAMMER was always outrun.
