Footnotes

MY BOY ANGIE trailed down the backside racing mid track, hit stride past the quarter pole, swung six wide circling the field entering the stretch, surged in last jumps to snare the victory from DALTON GANG under an all out drive. DALTON GANG rushed from the gate, set a pressured pace throughout, edged clear mid stretch, was fully extended coming to the wire, was wore down in final strides missing in a very hard effort. ONE BLUE SKY settled in mid pack, raced along the rail throughout, closed willingly from upper stretch, game try. DURAND PARK stalked down the backside, lost position on the bend running between rivals, chased the runner up top of the stretch, lacked late kick and was outfinished battling for minor awards. NO FEAR HEAR showed good early foot, pressed around the turn racing two to three wide, began to tire inside the furlong marker, no late threat. ANDRUN tracked to mid turn, rallied four wide to almost draw even for the lead at the quarter pole, soon flattened out mid stretch, used up. COFFEE GOSSIP settled towards the rear, faded from the quarter pole, never factored. LEGS TIME hustled to give a brief chase, dropped off from the quarter pole, stopped at the eighth pole and was eased across the finish line.
