MIRACLE IN MAY stalked ON MY WAY HOME from the start, angled out challenging for the lead top of the lane, drove clear in mid stretch, was hard ridden holding safe to the finish. PRESSTHEHARDWAYS rated early saving ground, angled out at the quarter pole, came four wide upper stretch, dueled running between foes coming to the wire, inched up late winning the battle for second place. GRIBBLE'S GAMBLE settled towards the rear, swung out five wide for the stretch run, surged belatedly just missing second place in a game try. WITH GRATITUDE well placed along the rail down the backside, angled to split foes upper stretch, bid in tandem late for a minor award but was outgamed besting rest. ON MY WAY HOME broke alertly and angled to the rail, set a solid pace throughout, headed in upper stretch, gave way inside the eighth pole, used up. OH MICKEY was always outrun, never involved. PROUD DAME tracked running along the rail, chased under urging from mid turn, lacked response giving way leaving the quarter pole.
