DIXIE N SPADES hustled to engage DONE GOOSE shortly after the start, drew clear of that rival near the quarter pole, angled to the rail in upper stretch, was under strong left handed stick during the stretch run, held firm under constant pressure. RAMBLIN ROSIE raced up close along the rail, chased the winner into the stretch, could not menace late but was a willing second best. LEVIS BEAU broke in mid pack, advanced four wide mid turn, was hard ridden entering the stretch, needed more late. DONE GOOSE broke alertly and pressed DIXIE N SPADES from the start, remained a threat to top of the lane, bore out sharply and rider had to take up, was straightened out mid stretch, continued on willingly after that costly mishap. SOUL PURPOSE was off a step slow, traveled in the second flight, split foes upper stretch, closed ground belatedly but was no threat. LAELIA lacked speed, raced inside throughout, angled out slightly in upper stretch, gave a belated gain after the fact. THE CAT'S REACH well placed, stalked three wide on the turn, asked for more, had no response, tired mid stretch. BURNED SIENNA was outrun early, beat two weary rivals in the drive, never involved. LATONIA STORM hustled to give a brief chase racing five wide, faded leaving the quarter pole. PATSY'S NIGHTMARE lacked speed, came five wide into the stretch, offered little.
