DIXIE'S JUBILEE broke evenly, was quickly rushed into the turn to duel for command, vied three deep mid turn, cleared and angled over to the rail in upper stretch, lead was rapidly diminishing coming to the wire despite being under severe pressure, just held on. LANTERN COURT was unhurried leaving the gate, asked mid turn, came five wide top of the lane, hit best stride mid stretch, closed fast on the winner to miss in a very game effort. SECRET BROOK rated early, saved ground on the turn, angled out under a drive entering the lane, rallied between foes mid stretch, closed willingly. TWOSIE'S BEST sent hard, set a pressured pace throughout, battled to upper stretch, ceded stubbornly, good try. DIAMOND WHIM showed high speed to press TWOSIE'S BEST from the start, put a head in front near the quarter pole while vying between rivals, drifted towards the rail in upper stretch, weakened inside the eighth pole. ENERGY COUNTS hustled to stalk the pace racing along the rail, chased under urging at the quarter pole, lacked response, weakened top of the stretch. IMPERIAL GRACE was off a step slow, was always outrun,no factor. BLUEGRASS BREEZE hustled to mount a brief bid on the turn, swung five wide under a drive entering the stretch, had no late kick, gave way mid stretch.
