**Footnotes**

DEPUTY DIRECTOR slow early found stride to upper stretch, appeared beaten when finding a final surge to get up on the wire. WW KOOKY MONSTER laid close up bidding clear on the turn then digging near the rail down the stretch, looked safe when grabbed in the last stride. DECLARATION tracked the pace through the turn looming abreast rivals in upper stretch, hard ridden to wire needed a bit more. SIRR PURR slow early was angled to mid track in upper stretch finishing under a stiff drive. SIXTH FORMAL squeezed at the break was rushed off the pace weakening in drive. KYLE'S TREASURY raced second flight failing to menace while finishing wide. EL MERLOT (ARG) had little response. CONNOISSEUR broke quickly to the top, passed on the turn would wilt in upper stretch.
