THREEWISEMEN broke alert pressing a short lead to upper stretch, extended abreast AMERICAN MINER would wear down rival drawing out in the three path. AMERICAN MINER hustled out pressed then chased from the inside through the turn, continued along rail down the lane ceding to THREEWISEMEN while using all late to save place. STREATERVILLE in close early moved evenly through the turn, rallied to upper stretch bidding willingly late four wide. GANGSTER RAFT stalked close up through the turn, extended to upper stretch would weaken late four wide. U R DA BEST in close early was rushed hard five wide on the turn, extended in upper stretch weakened near mid track. NEVEREVERYIELD tracked evenly through the turn, came five wide through the stretch gradually wearing down. KAYLA O slow early angled inside on the turn, proved no threat along the rail. FASHIONABLE TIME broke slowly, was circled six wide in upper stretch laboring home. MOODY COACH dropped back on the turn. SOUPER VEX was always outrun.
